WHAT IS ART CAMP?

Art Camp is an exciting summer program for LaPorte area kids to experience an enriching program outside of the school art classroom. Participants will have a chance to do a variety of art activities in the picturesque setting of Cummings Lodge which is located within Soldiers Memorial Park on the shores of Stone Lake.

WHO IS IT FOR?

Art Camp is for students currently enrolled in grades pre-school and K through 7th. New and returning students will be doing art projects appropriate for their age group. Returning participants will experience new activities and art projects during the 2010 Art Camp. Middle School sessions will focus on 2 dimensional art or 3 dimensional art projects. Students may attend one or both sessions.

WHEN WILL IT TAKE PLACE AND WHAT DOES IT COST?

Art Camp will take place **June 21 through July 22, 2010**. Two-week sessions will be offered at two different times. Participants may pick the two-week session that fits their summer schedule. (The projects taught during each two-week session will be repeated.) Art Camp will be held weekdays (Monday-Thursday).
