NO PERMIT WILL BE ISSUED UNTIL ALL OUTSTANDING PARKING TICKETS WITH THE LAPORTE VIOLATIONS BUREAU ARE SETTLED.

1. **It is unlawful for any person to:**
 - a. **Make any false or misleading statement in application for a permit.**
 - b. **Transfer a permit to another person or to a vehicle not authorized by the permit.**
 - c. **Alter a permit in any respect in order to gain privileges not authorized by the permit.**
 - d. **Display on a vehicle a permit that has been suspended or revoked.**
 - e. **Sell or receive anything of value in exchange for a permit.**
2. The penalty for a violation of this section shall be a fine of \$75.00

When properly issued and displayed, a residential parking permit shall authorize a specified vehicle to park in any two-hour parking space in the downtown area **except** on Lincolnway. The permit shall **not**:

- a. Authorize parking for more than 24 consecutive hours in any one location.
- b. Guarantee a parking space
- c. Exempt the vehicle or operator from observing zones where parking is prohibited at all or specified times (1AM to 6AM), including but not limited to permanent or temporary no parking zones, loading zones, fire zones, one-hour and 15 minute and 30 minute-restricted parking spaces, and
- d. Exempt the permit holder from other applicable regulations contained in Chapter 94 of the municipal code.

PLEASE BE A GOOD NEIGHBOR. DO NOT PARK ALL DAY IN FRONT OF A BUSINESS WHOSE LIVELIHOOD WOULD BE JEOPARDIZED BY LACK OF NEARBY PARKING.
