Dear Residents of Monroe Manor,

The City was advised today that Rieth-Riley will begin work **this Friday and Saturday** (weather permitting) on curbs, asphalt and driveway approaches for the Monroe Manor project. Work will begin on Parkview, moving through the neighborhood one side at a time. Please be advised that:

- Curb Install The machinery and concrete trucks will need the entire road for construction.
 During the day, while this work takes place, we ask that no car be parked on a road being
 worked on. After work hours, cars can return to their homes for the evening, then be moved back to a side road until curbs are complete.
- **Asphalt** After curbs are poured, the road will receive a layer of asphalt. **Avoid any traffic** on new asphalt for at least 24-hours.
- Paving concrete driveway approaches Finally, after paving, driveway approaches will be poured one side of the street at a time. During this time, please park on the opposite side of the street. Avoid any traffic on new concrete for one-week.
